# DMX – Lighting

#### Floods

- Color Wash for walls
- Spots
  - Focused Highlighting Effect
    - Blowmold, Tree or Object
- Panels
  - Large Area Color Wash
- "16 Million Colors" Single Fixture
- Many types and sizes in each category
- Commercial and DIY products
- Pricing varies depending on:
  - Size, LED count, Feature Set




# DMX – RGB "Basics"

- 3 color Red-Green-Blue LED "elements"
  - Individual colors, or by mixing, "up" to 16 Million
- Sizes/types of LEDs
  - T1 = Traditional LEDs
  - Superflux/Piranha = 4 pin
  - 5050 = surface mount device
- Communications Chips
  - 6803 2801 1804 "et al"
  - Manage data and communication
  - Influence color depth
  - Voltage
- Power Requirements 12V, 5V
- May require DMX Module to provide Base Address

# DMX – RGB Elements

- **Pixels/Modules/Nodes** (as defined by presenter, you opinion may vary)
  - Pixel
    - Any single light source with individual **RGB** control
    - Can use discrete **RGB** LEDS
  - Module
    - A unit with one or more pixels grouped together
    - Square, round, rectangular
  - Node (Some call this a pixel)
    - **RGB** light source with a "brain"
    - Smart Strings/Intelligent Mini Lights
  - North Pole Globes
  - Mega Trees / Mega Decoration Balls
  - Coro Elements (ex. Stars, Snowflakes)

# DMX – RGB Elements

#### Ribbon/Rope/Strip

- Flexible
- Cut to length
  - Configurable with 90's and "T"'s
- Outlines (ex. Windows/Roof Ridges)
- Arches
- Mega Trees
- Message/Picture Matrix









# DMX – Special Effects


#### Bubble

- Fun mystical effect
- Lasers
  - Range of effects
    - Brilliance beams, pictures, words, patterns
    - FDA and FAA permitting may be required

#### Fog/Co2

- Screens
- Graveyard effects
  - How-To's on Internet for Fog Coolers to keep fog at ground level
  - Affect movement with small fans
- Smoke Stacks for plastic/wireframe trains
- Fire
  - Fire and brimstone effect for Halloween
  - Check with your local Fire Department for permitting
  - Use with extreme caution and care! Not for amateurs


# DMX – Special Effects

#### Matrix

- Video
  - Fixed modules assembled to specific size
  - Flexible fabric bought to specific size
    - Available in various resolutions
    - Finer resolutions = higher cost

#### Scanners

- Gobo and Beam effects
- No special permits, or concerns like Lasers
- Snow
  - Simulate the real thing
- Yokes
  - Gobo and roving spot light effects
- Zap Strobes
  - Takes Curtain Strobes to a WHOLE new level
  - "Wow!" Effect
- Dozens of different types of fixtures to leverage in a display
  - Search the web and forums for examples, use your creativity

# DMX – Miscellaneous

- AC Dimming Packs
  - Used to control AC power, on/off/fade

#### Animatronics

- Motors and Servos
  - Fixed movement (in/out, side/side), rotation
  - Used in conjunction with arms, linkages, gears, pulleys
    - 2D & 3D Characters
    - Merry-go-Rounds
    - Ferris Wheels
    - Goblins from graves
  - Various power requirements 120V, 12V, 6V, 5V, 4.8V

#### Wireless Universes

• Flexibility in remote Universe/splits/branches

# **DMX - Implementation**

- Provides display creativity beyond blinky/flashy
- Will set you apart from other displays
- Will increase your sequenceable Channels
  - **RGB** Elements can add hundreds to thousands of channels
- Add a level of complexity and needs to have a plan
- Most DMX fixtures will require weatherproofing
- Fixtures requiring liquid needs extra consideration
  - Keep from freezing
  - Requires to be filled on a regular basis
